

Leaping Salmon

Have fun making your own Atlantic salmon model inspired by the new 50 pence coin – part of the set of British wildlife conservation themed coins of King Charles III.



Make your own model

Colour in and cut out your salmon model pieces.
Glue the tails and top edges of the fish's head and body together.



Atlantic salmon are known as the 'king of fish' and can live in both fresh and salty water. Young salmon hatch from eggs in rivers and then swim to the sea where they feed and grow into powerful swimmers. Adult fish must swim and leap their way upstream to lay their eggs in the same rivers where they once hatched.

Fold up the rectangle and glue it inside the body to space the curved rockers apart. Stand up your model and tap the salmon's nose to see it leap out of the water!
