Busy Bees

Have fun making your own animated scene of bees gathering nectar and pollen in a wild flower meadow. This activity is inspired by the new £1 and £2 coins – part of the set of British wildlife conservation themed coins of King Charles III.

Make your animated scene

Colour in and cut out your bees and flower meadow scene. Position the bee strip behind the slit in the scene, then glue the bee circle on top at one end of the strip. Pull the tab to see your bees buzz among the flowers!



Did you know?

There are more than 250 different bee species in Britain. These hard-working insects help to pollinate the flowers of plants and trees all around the country, which then produce fruits and seeds.

Spotting challenge

Look for these national flowers hidden in the meadow scene:

- a rose for England
- a daffodil for Wales
- a shamrock for Northern Ireland
- a thistle for Scotland.
