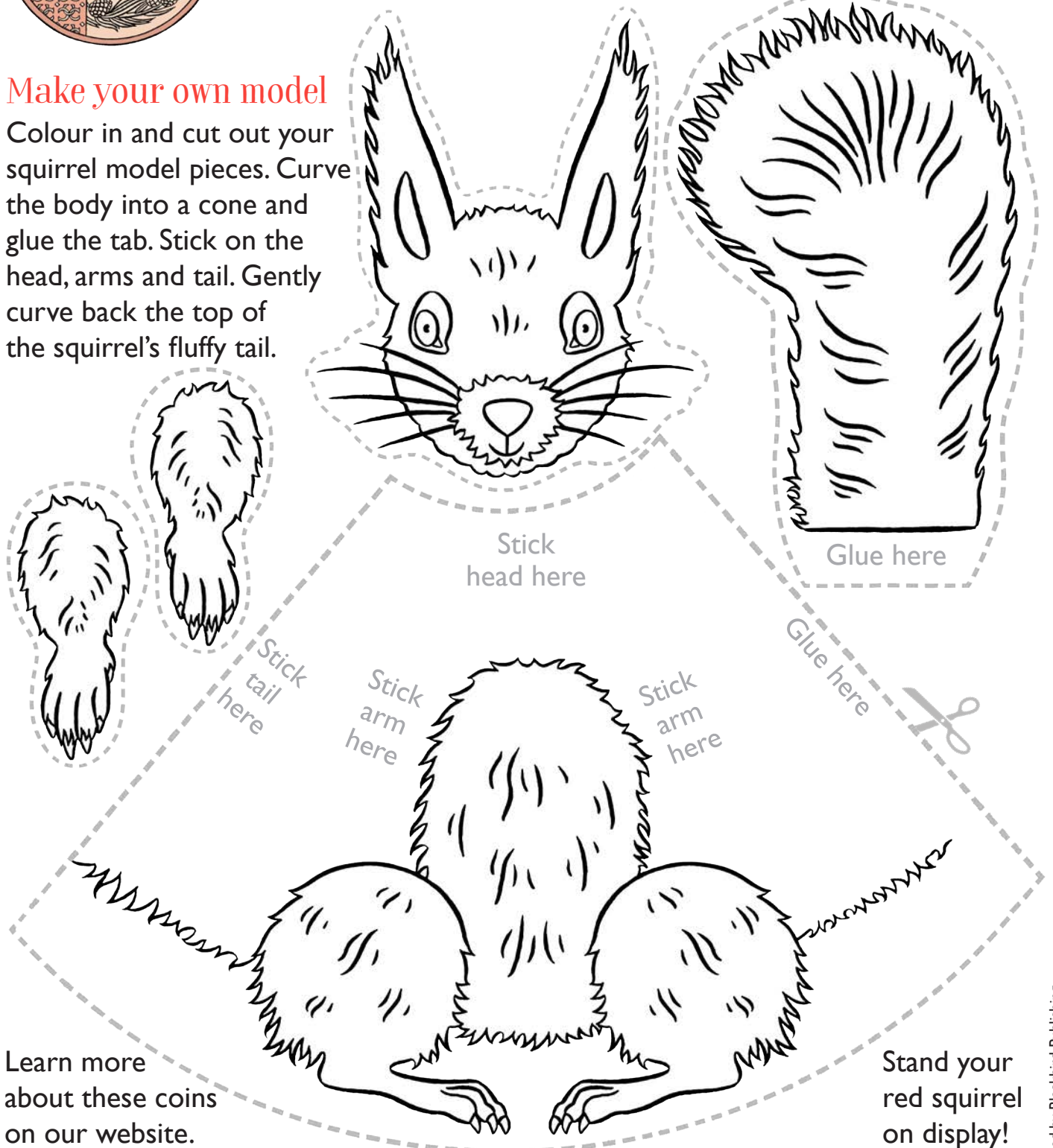
Rusty Red Squirrel

Colour in and cut out your squirrel model pieces. Curve the body into a cone and glue the tab. Stick on the head, arms and tail. Gently curve back the top of the squirrel's fluffy tail.

Stand your red squirrel on display!

Did you know?
Red squirrels have long fluffy tails and grow tall ear tufts in the winter. Most live in Scottish pine forests and northern woodlands, where they feed on pine seeds, hazelnuts and acorns. Squirrels use leafy twigs to build their untidy nests called dreys up in the treetops.
