

Now you have your coin design you can make a model using air dry clay to see what your design looks like in 3D.

Look at the examples of plaster model that have been made at the Royal Mint for inspiration

To make your model, take a piece of air dry clay. Make sure it's enough for you to work easily with.

Start by shaping it into a round disk.

You can use your fingers or tools to make marks in the clay for your design.

Try using found objects, such as leaves, and press them into the clay to make patterns.

Once you're happy with your design, leave it over night to dry fully.
